Dear Ukrainian Dance Enthusiasts:

We invite you to participate in the 17th Pavlychenko Folklorique Ensemble Dance Showcase. The festival will take place from Thursday, April 20th to Sunday, April 23rd, 2023 at Prairieland Park, Hall A, 503 Ruth Street East, Saskatoon, SK.

There have been a number of changes to our registration package since our last in-person festival. We encourage all participants to review the conditions and regulations prior to completing the online registration process. The online registration link can be found at http://www.pfedanceshowcase.com/sign-in/. Please note that the e-mail address used to complete the online registration process will be the primary means of communication for the dance group. Programs, schedules, and additional information will be sent to this e-mail address only.

Our registration deadline is January 15th, 2023 at 11:59 PM. Entry fees are due within five business days of the entry deadline (January 20th, 2023). Entries are accepted on a first come, first serve basis only, based on receipt of payment. Any special requests as to date and/or time of performance(s) must be made in writing at the time of entry, via the online registration process. Any requests received outside of the online registration process will not be considered. We have a limited number of entries available.

We anticipate the release of the preliminary program schedule in February. Any requests for changes to the initial program schedule must be submitted prior to March 1st, 2023. All requests for changes to the preliminary program must be made from the same e-mail address that created the original registration entry.

On Saturday, following the final adjudication session, a Showcase Concert will be held to highlight medium and large group dances chosen by the adjudicators and the Showcase Committee. The Showcase Concert will include scholarship presentations and a performance by Pavlychenko Folklorique Ensemble. The Showcase Concert is free to attend and open to the general public. The registered instructor for entries asked to perform in the Showcase Concert will be contacted via the contact information provided upon signing in to the festival.

PFE Dance Showcase is intended to highlight Ukrainian dance talent from across the provinces. Our goal is to encourage Ukrainian dancers to showcase their performance skills and build positive relationships between dancers and groups.

PFE Dance Showcase 2023 Entry Fees

Please be advised that PFE Dance Showcase 2023 fees are as follows:

Solo: \$20.00/dancer

Duet: \$16.00/dancer

Small Group: \$12.00/dancer

Medium Group: \$12.00/dancer

Large Group: \$12.00/dancer

Payment methods include cash, cheques, or e-transfers.

Cash and cheques may be dropped off in person or mailed. Cheques shall be made payable to "Pavlychenko Folklorique Ensemble, Inc.". Please place cash or cheques in an envelope and clearly state the name of the dance school, either on the envelope or in a brief note, and address envelopes as follows:

This year we will also be accepting payment via **e-transfer**. If you would like to e-transfer your entry fees, fees are to be sent to <u>treasurer@pfedance.com</u>. You MUST use the password <u>Showcase2023</u>, AND include a message that clearly states the name of the dance school.

Please note that no refunds will be issued for groups or individuals who choose to withdraw or cancel prior to or during the festival for any reason. However, in the event that the Showcase Committee must cancel PFE Dance Showcase 2023, a full refund for all registration fees will be issued.



CONDITIONS, REGULATIONS, & SYLLABUS INFORMATION

- 1. The adjudicators' decisions are final.
- 2. The Showcase Committee reserves the right to split or combine classes or age groups according to the number of entries received.
- 3. Any complaints must be made in writing and submitted to the Showcase Coordinator. If complaints are improperly made, or the adjudicator is approached, the person or group may be asked to leave the festival.
- 4. No coaching is allowed during the performance. Disregarding this rule will result in disqualification.
- No cameras or video recorders are allowed during the performances, but are welcome during the awards presentations.
- 6. Adjudication feedback is provided to participants in video format. Adjudicators may choose to provide paper copies in the form of an adjudication sheet, at their discretion. Festival volunteers will provide any adjudication sheets directly to the instructors or designated group representatives following the adjudication session.
- 7. All cancellations must be made to the Showcase Coordinator at least one hour prior to the start of the session.
- 8. PFE Dance Showcase is not responsible for any injury incurred during the festival.
- 9. Dancers will be called onto the stage for adjudication. The Showcase Committee reserves the right to limit the number of participants on stage for adjudication. The Backstage Coordinator will advise groups as to how many dancers will be permitted on stage during any given adjudication.
- 10. A stereo system with an auxiliary cord will be provided for rehearsal areas and the main stage. Instructors will be responsible for playing their own music, both for rehearsals and performances. Cassette tapes and CDs will not be accepted. If using devices (i.e. iPod, phones, etc.) they must be fully charged and properly labeled. You must provide your own adaptors.
- 11. No entry or exiting the auditorium during performances.
- 12. PFE Dance Showcase is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- 13. Dance groups will be held responsible for any damages caused by their dancers and will be liable for paying the damage fee(s).
- 14. Foul language will not be tolerated. Dancers are expected to behave appropriately.
- 15. No smoking is allowed in the building.
- 16. Showcase Concert: A number of dances will be selected to perform in our Saturday evening Showcase Concert. The Adjudicators and Showcase Committee will determine the final selection of medium and large group dances. Solos, duets, and small groups are not eligible to perform in the Showcase Concert.



17. AGE LIMITS: Age of contestant shall be considered as of February 1, 2023. Group age is determined by the average age of all dancers in the group, to the nearest year.

Age Categories are as follows:

6 years and under 9-10 years 13-14 years 17-18 years 30+ years*

7-8 years 11-12 years 15-16 years 19-29 years* Adjudication Only**

*Entries in age categories of 19-29 and 30+ years are not eligible for scholarships.

**The Adjudication Only category enables dancers to participate in the festival when meeting the following criteria: entries from groups whose dancers either receive payment for performances (excluding honoraria) or hold auditions for the group. These dances are not eligible for scholarships or medals.

- 18. AWARDS: To be awarded as per festival program.
- 19. MEDALS: Medals will be awarded to dances as follows:

Gold: 90% - 100% Silver: 85% - 89% Bronze: 80% - 84%

Each solo, duet, and small group will be adjudicated and given a mark by either of the two adjudicators. Both adjudicators will adjudicate medium and large group dances, and an average of the two marks will be given to the group.

20. TIMING: Time limits are as follows:

Solos 2.0 minutes maximum
Duets 2.0 minutes maximum
Small Groups 4.0 minutes maximum
Medium Groups 4.5 minutes maximum
Large Groups 5.0 minutes maximum

If a dance exceeds the specified maximum time restriction, the instructor/school will be automatically fined \$25.00. Timing begins when the first dancer steps on stage and ends when the final dancer leaves the stage (including bows). The fine must be paid to the Showcase Coordinator. Payment will be accepted in the form of either cash or cheque made payable to PFE Dance Showcase. Adjudication videos will not be released until the overtime fees have been paid.

21. ENTRIES:

Solos 1 dancer
Duets 2 dancers
Small Groups 3-6 dancers
Medium Groups 7-12 dancers
Large Groups 13 or more dancers

Entries are split into male, female, and mixed categories.

If a dancer is unable to participate due to illness or injury, the dance will be adjudicated based on the number of participants that appear on stage.



22. CLASSIFICATION:

We are pleased to see that Ukrainian dance is expanding to encompass a wider range of ethnographic regions. Therefore, our classification system is based on the following seven regions or sub-regions.
